The Christie Hospital

Britspace Modular Buildings is working closely with The Christie Hospital to provide a new clinical trials building for the pioneering hospital.

As one of Europe's leading cancer centres, treating over 40,000 patients a year, the hospital was in need of the new medical facility as part of the £35m re-development of their patient treatment centres.

The clinical trials facility consists of 22 steel-frame modules, manufactured offsite in Britspace's modern, purpose built facilities. With a large majority of the fit-out and finishes being completed in the factory, Britspace was able to offer a significantly reduced programme compared to that of traditional construction.

The experienced Britspace construction site team is currently preparing the site whilst the health facility is being manufactured. Delivery and installation is due to start at the beginning of October 2008.
